Onsite Homeschool Tours

Our enthusiastic Biologists each have a 4-year degree in a Life Science Related Field. By combining rescued wildlife and observational learning we bring the Life Sciences....to LIFE.

2 Hour Life Science Adventure Tour - Our Biologists will lead students through the following four stations:

Station 1 - Guided Tour: This serves as an introduction to our Center. Students will observe over 50 species of exotic and native wildlife.

Station 2 - Animal Classification: Students will meet a variety of animals for a lesson on how animals are related. They will have an opportunity to ask questions, interact with a few of the animals, and examine intriguing biofacts!

Station 3 - Food Webs: Students will explore the dynamics of "the circle of life." It is important to understand that in the natural world living things interact to maintain a properly balanced ecosystem. Students will be familiarized with the terms producer, consumer, herbivore, carnivore, omnivore, and meet animal examples.

Station 4 - Animal Adaptations: An adaptation is a special characteristic an animal has to help it survive. Students will compare and contrast animals to see the adaptations each has for their vastly different environments.

2 Hour Animal Husbandry Tour - Our Biologists will lead students through the following four stations:

Station 1 - Guided Tour: This station is an orientation of the outdoor habitats and the reptile, amphibian, and arthropod room. Students will observe over 50 species of exotic and native wildlife!

Station 2 - Animal Husbandry: At this learning station the basics of animal husbandry will be explored. Students will compare human hygiene and healthcare with the care we give our animals. They will even have an opportunity to groom a fennec fox, compare their heartbeat to an animal's heartbeat, and feed a North American Porcupine!

Station 3 - Wildlife Education: When taking care of animals it is important to know as much as possible about each species as well as each individual animal. One of our biologists will present a variety of animals and their characteristics for a lesson on classification. Students are given an opportunity to ask questions, interact with a few of these animals, and examine some interesting biofacts!

Station 4 - Animal Training & Enrichment: This station introduces scouts to the fundamentals of operant conditioning. They learn basic "clicker training" techniques and positive reinforcement, and then participate in an animal training session. Students will also learn the importance of stimulating an animal's natural behaviors through behavioral enrichment. Each student will create an enrichment item and then observe the animals enjoying their new "toys".

Off-site Homeschool Programs

We can also bring our animals to your homeschool group OFF-SITE. Our enthusiastic biologists present the animals in a fun and informative way. We encourage questions and observations with each animal stimulating your child's natural desire to learn and explore in their own unique way. Group size is limited to 50 or less to safely allow touching of some of the animals. Children can touch all of the reptiles, but for safety reasons, we do not let the public touch the exotic mammals during our off-site events.
